

Today's Sermon: In the Easter Resurrection Garden! Reversing Eden, Restoring Paradise





Guest Speaker Next Sunday



Confirmation students have a Faith Night on Wednesday, April 24 with supper at 6:00. Faith Partners will be joining them. Remember to bring your bible.




Next Sunday
