This Sunday – Reset Direction

Whether we've been in the church for a long time or are exploring the faith, Jesus sometimes calls us to move in a new direction, even when we think we are already heading in the right direction.



Scripture Reading | Acts 9:1-15

Meanwhile, Saul was still breathing out murderous threats against the Lord's disciples. He went to the high priest and asked him for letters to the synagogues in Damascus, so that if he found any there who belonged to the Way, whether men or women, he might take them as prisoners to Jerusalem. As he neared Damascus on his journey, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice say to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" "Who are you, Lord?" Saul asked.

"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting," he replied. "Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do." The men traveling with Saul stood there speechless; they heard the sound but did not see anyone. Saul got up from the ground, but when he opened his eyes he could see nothing. So they led him by the hand into Damascus. For three days he was blind, and did not eat or drink anything.

Ottie Otness Memorial Blood Drive


Buffalo United Methodist Church will host a Red Cross Blood drive on **February 29th from 10AM** American Blood Services to 4PM. There is currently a critical need for

Apportionments for 2024

We are fortunate to be part of a connectional church, and apportionments are the local financial commitment we make to the greater United Methodist Church. This amount is calculated by the conference using a formula based primarily on operating budget, and slightly on membership numbers. These funds support administration, pensions, mission infrastructures, ministry training and so much more! The total amount BUMC is asked to pay for 2024 is \$36,082, which works out to \$139.00 per member. Some people feel good about paying that amount up front in addition to their regular giving; others consider it to be a part of their regular pledge. Either way, we want you to be aware that as a member of this congregation, \$139.00 is sent on to the conference on your behalf out of our general fund.
