### **Sunday — What is Love?**

If we're going to commit to following the "way of love" together, then it's crucial that we agree on what love is and isn't. We all have an intuitive sense of what love is and recognize that we all need it. But God's Word and example often paints a different picture of love than the one we might paint for ourselves.



### **Sunday Scripture**

If I could speak all the languages of earth and of angels, but didn't love others, I would only be a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I had the gift of prophecy, and if I understood all of God's secret plans and possessed all knowledge, and if I had such faith that I could move mountains, but didn't love others, I would be nothing. If I gave everything I have to the poor and even sacrificed my body, I could boast about it; but if I didn't love others, I would have gained nothing.

Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance. Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13 NLT

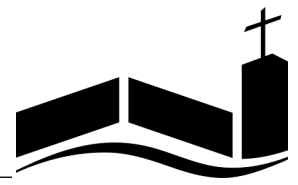
### **Next Sunday Feb. 28 — Making Do, Making New**

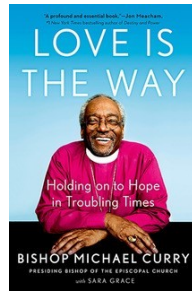




## Other Ministry Updates
