Next Sunday – Reset on God's Power | 2 Timothy 1:6-9 (NIV)





Last Sunday, we kicked off our new breakthrough prayer opportunity called the Dynamite Prayer Initiative. The Bishop is inviting all churches in North and South Dakota and Minnesota to participate in reading Dynamite Prayer – A 28 Day Experiment.

Meals and Missions


