### **Next Sunday — Trust in God's Righteousness**

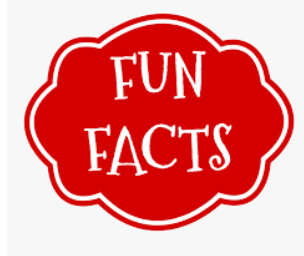

### Nursery Attendant Wanted

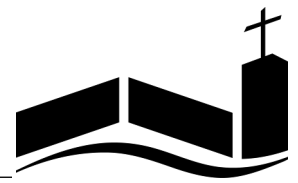

### FREE Summer Reading in the Park is Underway!

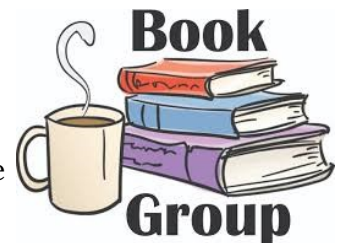
