
Sunday Scripture



Next Sunday — Cry Out to God for Help



Book Groups

Two books have been suggested as very good books to read for our BUMC book groups. One is, *Before We Were Yours* by Lisa Wingate and the other is, *American Dirt* by Jeanine

Book Group Cummins. *Before We Were Yours* is based on the heartbreaking true scandal of Georgia Tann, a woman whose Memphis adoption center kidnapped and sold poor children to wealthy families. Authors praised the novel for its "heart-racing" and shocking tale of struggle, hope, and redemption. *American Dirt* is an urgent, blistering, unforgettable book. In her portrayal of Lydia and Luca, a mother and son forced to leave their Mexican home, Jeanine Cummins has given face to migrants everywhere who flee violence and near-certain death in search of only one thing: a chance at life.
