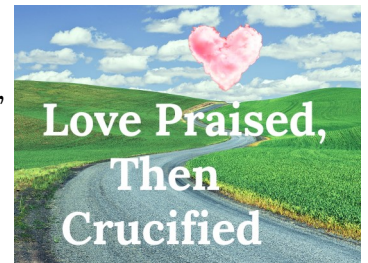

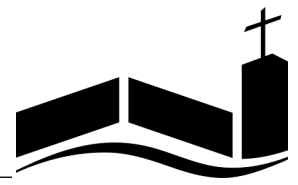


### **Next Sunday April 4 Easter Sunday— Love Conquers Death**

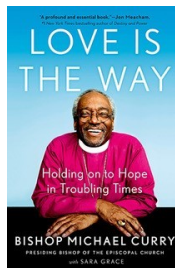

### Spend Time in the Easter Resurrection Garden

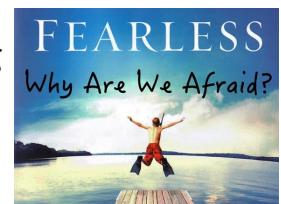


Though we won't be worshipping in person on Easter Sunday, you can still spend time in the Easter Garden if you'd

### Call for Pictures for FEARLESS Worship Series

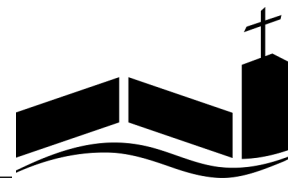
On April 18, we'll be starting a new worship series about living the resurrection life as fearless Easter people.
