## New Sermon Series—A New Creation

Easter is all about celebrating the new life Jesus makes possible for us! We often think of this new life in terms that are only spiritual or individual, but Jesus' resurrection means new life for *all* of creation – yes, for us, but also for our communities and our environment. In a world grappling with environmental concerns, join us as we delve into scripture to understand how the renewed life Jesus offers shapes our responsibility to care for our environment and all its inhabitants.

**This Sunday — Easter: Hope for All Creation** | Mark 16:1-15 & Psalm 96:1-2, 11-13 In resurrecting, Jesus gives us hope for new life. This hope is life and joy for *all* creation!

**Scripture Reading** | Psalm 96:1-2, 11-13 Sing to the Lord a new song;

sing to the Lord, all the earth. Sing to the Lord, praise his name;

proclaim his salvation day after day.

Let the heavens rejoice, let the earth be glad;

let the sea resound, and all that is in it. Let the fields be jubilant, and everything in them;

let all the trees of the forest sing for joy.

Let all creation rejoice before the Lord, for he comes,

he comes to judge the earth.

He will judge the world in righteousness

and the peoples in his faithfulness.


