Sermon Series— Rising Strong

“...just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life,” (Romans 6:4b). The Bible is full of stories of redemption, change, and hope. Through four of those stories, we will discover how faith in a Risen Jesus can transform our lives for the better here and now. No matter how big or how small we fall, God outstretches God's hand, ready to raise us up.



This Sunday — Rising Strong from Darkness to Light | John 9:1-11

This Sunday, be inspired by John 9:1-11 and including a moving story from Pastor and author Max Lucado. In John's gospel, Jesus heals a man born blind—not because of sin, but so “the works of God might be revealed in him.”

Our worship this Sunday will also include Holy Communion. In the United Methodist Church, all are welcome at the table, as we understand Communion to be the gift of Jesus Christ to anyone of any age who desires a closer relationship with Him.

Scripture Reading | John 9:1-11

As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, “Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?”

“Neither this man nor his parents sinned,” said Jesus, “but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him. As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world.”

After saying this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. “Go,” he told him, “wash in the Pool of Siloam” (this word means “Sent”). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.

Next Sunday — Rising Strong: From Uncertainty to Confidence | Deuteronomy 31:8 “8

In honor of our graduating seniors, we will focus on *Oh, the Places You'll Go!*, by Dr. Seuss. His book paints a delightful and honest description of life; with its ups and downs—from soaring successes to painful slumps and confusing crossroads. Reviewing characters in the Bible, we'll see how Rising strong from uncertainty to more confidence in life's journey means choosing to trust the Lord and yourself. It means stepping carefully in a world that's messy and mixed-up sometimes and that we are never alone on the journey.

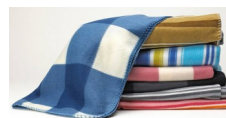
UMC Summer Camp
