Next Sunday- All In | Sermon Series

When we face important decisions and opportunities in our lives, we often weigh the pros and cons. We often find reasons to avoid making changes and to keep doing things the same old way. But there comes a time when we must decide... are we going to play it safe or go all in? John 3:16 tells us that God loved us so much that he gave his only Son for us, "so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may

have eternal life." God's love for us is "all in"! In turn, when we put all our trust in God, our lives can be freed for unimaginable wonder. This series will explore what it means to be "all in" for God with all we have and all we are.

Oct 1: The Risk Scripture: John 3:16; Luke 5:1-11 When we say yes to following Jesus, it means we say yes to the risks.

Oct 8: Common Good Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:4–13 God activates gifts in everyone for the common good.

Oct 15: No Strings Attached Scripture: Acts 2:43-47 The gifts given by the Spirit are not to be used only in the local church community, but also to bless the wider community.

Oct 22: Commit Scripture: Ephesians 4:22-24, John 3:16 On this "Commitment Sunday," we can play it safe or go all in.

We are pleased to report our FRESH EXPRESSIONS Informational Meeting (held last Sunday) was a strong and encouraging




beginning to this new initiative!
